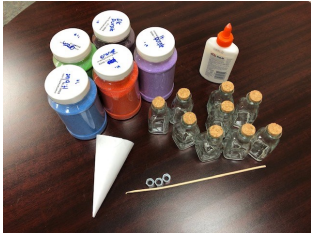


SAND ART HANUKKAH MENORAH – HOW TO!



1. Gather supplies– jars (purchased or old jars from around the house), glue, skewer or toothpick, 10 3/8 hex nuts, funnel, sand or homemade colored salt.

MAKE YOUR OWN SAND ALTERNATIVE – COLORED SALT

- A. Place salt in a re-sealable bag and add liquid food coloring. Seal up the bag and mix until the color is evenly distributed.
- B. Place salt on a piece of paper and color it with chalk.



2. Fill up the jar with your sand/salt.
3. Use your toothpick or skewer to create designs with the sand/salt.



4. Put a layer of glue on the top of the sand/salt to keep the sand/salt in place.



5. After the glue has dried glue the nuts directly onto the sand or on the lids of the jars. Make sure to glue two nuts together for the Shamash to make it a different height.



6. Set up your jars in whatever order you like and enjoy your Hanukkah menorah.
