
# MATZAH BOX MATZAH HOLDER – HOW TO!

## <u>SUPPLY LIST</u>

- Matzah Box
- Tape
- Mod Podge or Glue Stick
- Paint Brush
- Scrap Paper, Tissue Paper, Stickers, Old Magazines
- Scissors

	5. Tape the inside flaps to give the box more stability.
	6. Place matzah inside and enjoy your new matzah holder!






- Paper Matzah Holder Print Out

- Stapler




Matzah	5. Color the Matzah Holder Paper using crayons or colored pencils.

	9. Place matzah in holder and enjoy!





















CRAFT STICK MATZAH HOLDER – HOW TO!		
<ul> <li><u>SUPPLY LIST</u></li> <li>Craft Sticks</li> <li>White Glue</li> <li>Paint (Optional)</li> <li>Paint Brushes/ Q-Tip</li> <li>Scissors</li> </ul>		
	1. Gather Supplies.	
	2. Place 23 sticks down next to each other. Place glue on the ends of each and lay four sticks down.	
	3. Place glue dots on four sticks. For kids that are struggling with the glue bottle, place glue on a piece of paper or in a cup and use a paint brush or q-tip for dabbing.	
	4. Place two sticks on the short ends and two sticks in the middle.	

	5. Place glue dots on four more sticks and place two sticks on each of the long ends.
<image/>	6. Continue the pattern building up as tall as you desire.
	7. <b>Optional-</b> after the sticks dry you can paint the box.
<b>EDERTAND</b>	8. <b>Optional</b> - you can cut popsicle sticks to decorate the box with the Hebrew or English word Matzah- බහ
